HOW DOES NAO MAKER SPACE WORK?

The local library purchases or is granted a NAO Robot along with a library software site license specially designed to allow for multiple users to have access to the robot's programming software for their own personal developmental use on their own computer. This software allows users to simulate the programming of the robot. When they wish to test their robotics software development on the actual robot they come to the library for reserved time as individuals or a team to connect their software to the actual robot to test its performance of the tasks or routines they created.
